Our Community Centre encourages the inclusion of all Paralowie school families and staff members and we love offering and hosting many events and activities for everyone to enjoy.

Our focus is to be a safe and accessible second home for our school families and Hub participants and we welcome all people from many and diverse backgrounds. As a staff we offer help to those who need support and love to celebrate member achievements. We are about adult learning and parent participation, offering a crèche three times a week whilst running our English, Citizenship support and computing classes.

Hub Activities

ENGLISH CLASSES

In 2023 we offered 3 English conversation support classes, 1 class specifically for Citizenship support and another Nepalese Citizenship support class. Selia works with all our adult participants to assist them in gaining more confidence with their English conversation skills and to further develop their reading and writing skills. CRECHE FUN

In Term 3 this year we welcomed 2 new staff members to our Hub team. Win and Sidiqa share the 3 days we offer creche sessions to support our adult learning. They have fitted in to our Hub family so well and we are thrilled to enjoy their warmth and the fun energy they bring.





PLAYGROUP

Playgroup is held once a week in our crèche room! Early in the year Sadie visited us from **HIPPY** to talk to our parents about this great parent and child learning at home program. Every week is full of fun activities, music, craft and early learning, whilst parents can engage with each other and make new friends. This year our families participated in two new projects:

- 1. Play, Grow and Learn Garden Project
- 2. Toy Well Toy Library

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Playgroup offers a valuable opportunity for children to develop skills and confidence, and it helps them to 'get ready' for Kindergarten too!

PLAY, GROWN AND LEARN GARDEN PROJECT

This year we successfully received a \$10,000 grant from Australian Neighborhood Houses & Centres Association (ANHCA), to further develop the garden we started in 2022 with Green Adelaide. This grant has enabled us to engage volunteers and purchase garden equipment needed to create an outdoor nature space for our preschool aged school and their parents. This project has brought together a diverse range of people from our Hub, our school (parents and staff) and various community groups. Our volunteers are gaining new skills,



assisting with planning and learning about gardening at the same time. Thank you to Naomi from Green Adelaide for her time, sharing of her knowledge and invaluable support and to Parafield Bunnings and their Community Development Team for their donation of items for our garden project.







TOY LIBRARY AT PARALOWIE COMMUNITY HUB!

In October we celebrated the Official Opening of our new Toy Library.
